You are Pilot Tāne for this unique Aotearoa experience.

Your role? Keep the Cessna 172 on track by following the flight plan shown in your EFB/NavLog — and let your onboard guide, Aroha, handle the storytelling.

Over the 90 minutes, you'll cruise low and slow (ideally under 1500ft where possible) above the breathtaking landscapes of Tāmaki Makaurau (Auckland), from volcanic cones and rugged west coast beaches to lush native ranges and iconic city skylines.

Aroha will narrate the journey with rich Māori legends, classic Kiwi slang, and a touch of local humour — all voiced by a real human New Zealand Voice.

It's more than a flight — it's a heartfelt, entertaining, and unique Kiwi adventure.

flight simulator 2024 tips:


- In MSFS 2024, open the EFB to view your live flight plan with labelled POIs.
- Don't hop your character of the plane on the runway, it will finish the tour!
- You can optionally remove the Co-Pilot inside the EFB if you wish to have a better view out that side of the plane
- To turn off Subtitles, open Options → Accessibility, switch off "Subtitles" then
 Save and Back
- Not hearing our Tour Guide talking? Check 'Character Voices' volume under Options → General → Sound.

Kaitiaki	Guardian / Steward	Kai-tee-ah-kee
Tikanga	Customs / Protocols	Tee-kah-ngah
